WHAT IS THE DIGITAL LITERACY (DIGCOMP) - ADAPTIVE ONLINE TEST?

The Digital Literacy (DigComp) - Adaptive online test is a next-generation assessment test that adapts questions according to the answers provided by the candidate. The test quickly identifies the candidate's current level of proficiency on a five-level scale: initial, basic, productive, advanced and expert. Questions measure the candidate's ability to navigate in a digital environment.
