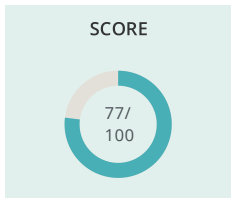

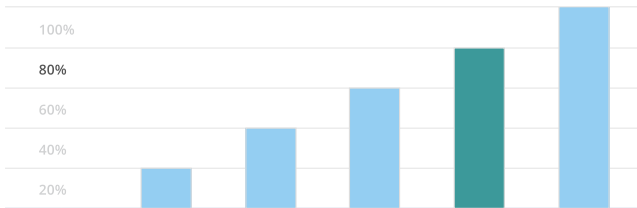

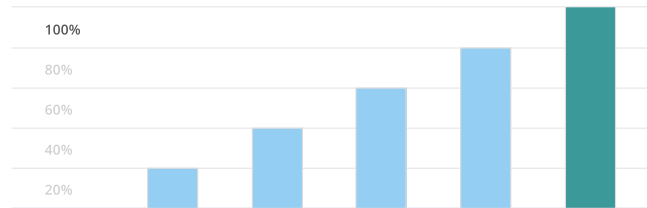
Subject-verb agreement



Domain description:

The questions in this domain focus on the candidate's ability to agree the verb with its subject in constructed sentences, with or without the presence of the auxiliaries being and having.

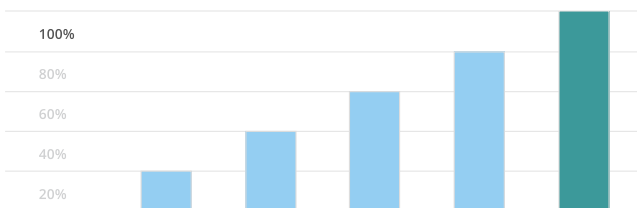
Homophones



Domain description:

The questions in this domain focus on the candidate's ability to choose the correct word in a sentence by selecting from several homophones.

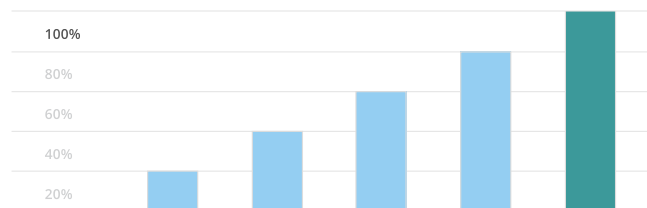
Agreement of past participles



Domain description:

This domain assesses candidates' ability to agree a verb with the past participle within a sentence while avoiding errors.

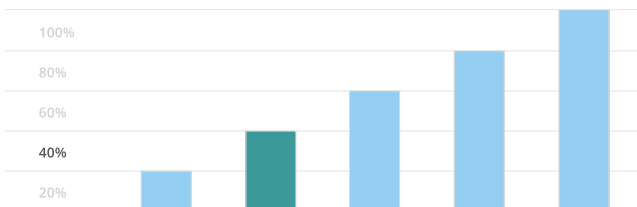
Spelling



Domain description:

This domain covers spelling knowledge of words, use of punctuation marks, knowledge of invariable words, and use of upper and lower case letters. The objective is to test the candidate's ability to recognize, differentiate and spell words, whether in a textual context or not (isolated word), and also to identify possible errors.

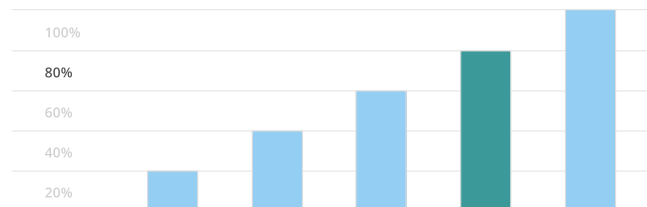
Anglicisms



Domain description:

This area assesses candidates' ability to understand a sentence in its entirety and to choose the appropriate term in French while avoiding the use of expressions or words of English origin.

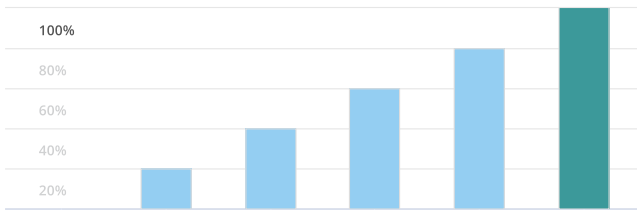
Conjugation



Domain description:

This domain deals with the various possible modes of conjugation including tenses, modes, genders, persons and agreements with the verbs "to be" and "to have". The objective is to test the candidate's ability to conjugate and agree a verb according to the context of a sentence or by following given instructions.

This domain covers skills on sentence structure and logical order in text.
